We have selected some of the finest British gins to display our heritage.

Hendrick's, Ayrshire 3.55*

Hendrick's Gin is a brand of gin produced in Girvan, Scotland, and was launched in 1999. In addition to the traditional juniper infusion, Hendrick's uses Rosa Damascena and specially selected cucumber to add flavour.

Recommended tonic pairing:
Fever-Tree Naturally Light

Poetic License Northern Dry Gin, Sunderland 3.55*

Poetic License Northern dry gin is a modern take on the classic dry style, with a fine balance of juniper pine, dry spices and citrus fruits, packed full of flavour and character.

Recommended tonic pairing:
Fever-Tree Mediterranean

Masons Gin, North Yorkshire 3.55*

Distilled using the traditional London dry gin method, in a traditional small copper alembic still, Masons Yorkshire Gin is truly a small batch craft gin. This smooth, well-rounded spirit is run in 200 litre batches and each bottle bears its own handwritten batch and bottle number.

Recommended tonic pairing:
Fever-Tree Elderflower

Whitley Neill Rhubarb & Ginger, Liverpool 3.55*

Whitley Neill Rhubarb & Ginger Gin is infused with the essence of rhubarb and extracts of real ginger giving it both a tart crispness and spicy, warming character.

Recommended tonic pairing:
Fever-Tree Naturally Light

Opihr Oriental Spiced Gin, Warrington 3.55*

Opihr Oriental Spiced Gin is crafted with a selection of exotic hand-picked botanicals, carefully chosen by Opihr's master distiller, including spicy cubeb berries from Indonesia, black pepper from India and coriander from Morocco.

Recommended tonic pairing:

Tanqueray Flor de Sevilla Orange London 3.55*

Flor de Sevilla is tangy, sweet gin inspired by the travels of Charles Tanqueray through the sun-drenched orange groves of Seville in the 1860s. The unique bittersweet character of Seville oranges balances wonderfully with the complexity of Tanqueray London Dry Gin.

Recommended tonic pairing:

Warner Edwards Elderflower 3.55*

The character of this base Harrington Dry Gin is evident. For example, juniper, rich spices, cinnamon, cassia, and a lot of cardamom. The aroma is bright and finished with some hints of Elderflower.

Recommended tonic pairing:

Sipsmith London Dry Gin, London 3.55*

Sipsmith is a small, independent distillery which crafts truly artisanal spirits of uncompromising quality. Their copper still, Prudence the first still in London for 200 years.

Recommended tonic pairing:

Portobello Road No171. London 3.55*

A gin specially designed by Jake Burger from the Portobello Star, home of the London Ginstitute. A solid and traditional London dry gin, distilled in west London.

Recommended tonic pairing:
Fever-Tree Mediterranean

Plymouth Dry Gin, Plymouth Black Friars 3.55*

Distillery, which dates back to the early 1400s, is the oldest working gin distillery in England. Plymouth Gin original has been distilled using the same blend of seven exotic botanicals, soft Dartmoor water and pure grain alcohol since 1793.

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Loch Lomond Original 3.55*

A satisfying, subtly peated single malt Scotch whisky from Loch Lomond. The distillery is renowned for being able to produce a multitude of whisky styles.

Glenfiddich 3.40*

Flowing in the Valley of the Deer since 1887, the family's signature expression is the world's most awarded single malt Scotch whisky. With a unique freshness from the same Highland spring water we've used since 1887, its distinctive fruitiness comes from the high cut point William Grant always insisted upon. Creamy with a long, smooth and mellow finish, our 12 year-old is the perfect example of Glenfiddich's unique Speyside style.

Glenmorangie 3.40*

The original expression of our elegant, floral spirit and the real backbone of the Glenmorangie range. A 10 year-old single malt, Glenmorangie original is produced by marrying the delicate spirit that emerges from Scotland's tallest stills, with first and second fill American white oak casks.

Glenkinchie 3.55*

Known as "The Edinburgh Malt" this 12 year-old is produced just fifteen miles from the city distillery founded in 1825 by brothers John and George Rate. The palate of this whisky is fruity with a medium length finish.

Talisker 3.55*

A classic whisky from the Isle of Skye and always highly rated, this whisky is known for its full-bodied spicy flavours with hints of tangy peat.

Dalwhinnie 3.55*

A great malt with simple flavours, the impeccable clean and crisp 15 year-old from Dalwhinnie distillery is consistently pleasing and always satisfies.

Oban 3.55*

Long before Oban was a lovely seaside resort town on the west coast of Scotland, John and Hugh Stevenson built their first still house there in 1794. So the town literally grew up around the whisky. The blokes at Oban have only one wash and one spirit still and the whisky they produce is considered one of the classic malts of Scotland – a virtual national treasure.

Cragganmore 3.55*

Cragganmore was the first distillery to be deliberately sited to take advantage of railway transport, and a private siding was built on the Strathspey railway to accommodate distillery traffic. Cragganmore distillery represents Speyside and proffers a rich, slightly floral whisky with barley notes.

Chivas Regal 3.40*

Chivas Regal 12 year-old is a blend of many different malt and grain Scotch whiskies with an aromatic infusion of wild herbs, heather, honey and orchard fruits. At the heart of all the Chivas Regal blends is the classic Speyside single malt whiskey, Strathisla. The Strathisla Distillery is the Scottish highlands' oldest operating distillery.

Auchentoshan Springwood 3.55*

Auchentoshan's Springwood expression, which spends its maturation resting in American oak bourbon casks, was released for travel retail. Rich in vanilla and orange, this is a flavoursome Lowland single malt, from a top distillery that triple distils its whisky.

If anyone has suggested adding a little water to your whisky, you may want to give it a try; Rather than watering it down, the addition may act as a flavour enhancement. Alternatively add a cube of ice; as the ice dilutes it helps the whisky open up.
